Toy Cleaning & Care

Please ensure all toys (especially baby toys) are cleaned thoroughly before returning to Toy Library.

Costumes should be washed and ironed before returning. Toys should not be left outside after use.

It is the borrowers responsibility to check the number of pieces of a toy before borrowing and returning. If any pieces are missing or broken please inform staff on the day you return them.



About Toy Library

We are a non-profit organisation that relies on volunteers to assist us in catering for the needs of our growing community. Children need a variety of toys that are safe, fun and provide learning opportunities.

Toy Library is a great alternative to buying expensive toys and can assist in developing your childs education. The extensive range of toys include: Babies & Toddler toys, Outdoor Play, Role Play, Musical Instruments, Puzzles, Games and Construction Toys.

Opening Hours

Monday 10.30 am - 12.30 pm Wednesday 9.00 am - 10.30 am Saturday 10.30 am - 12.00 noon

All toys must be returned during these hours. Toy library will not be open on public holidays or school holidays.

Cost

The annual cost of Toy Library is:

\$60 family membership - 2 duties required \$70 family membership - No duty required \$45 grandparents membership - duty optional \$80 Playgroups / Family Day Care / Non-profit organisations - duty optional

All fees are non-refundable. EFTPOS facilities are available on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Toy Borrowing Conditions

A maximum of 6 points (or 4 points for grandparents membership) can be borrowed at one time. Small toys are worth 1 borrowing point. Large toys are worth 2 points and only one can be borrowed at a time. Therefore the most that can be borrowed at one time is 1 large toy and 4 small toys (1 large toy and 2 small toys for grandparents).

Large Toys e.g. Ride on cars & bikes = 2 points each = 2 week borrowing

Small Toys e.g. Activities, games & puzzles = 1 point each = 2 week borrowing

Party Packs

Party packs are available for an additional cost of \$15. This entitles you to borrow 5 large toys at once, as well as your normal borrowing points. Party packs can be booked in advance and the toys are available on a first come first serve basis.

Party packs are to be returned at the beginning of the next session that we are open.

Late Toys

Toys are to be borrowed for a two week period. Toys that are returned late will incur a fine of \$5 per week.

Damaged Toys & Missing Pieces

Broken toys through misuse, i.e. rough handling or inappropriate age usage, will need to be replaced by the member or money in lieu of.

If a toy is missing a piece, the member can either re-borrow the toy and look for the missing piece and bring it back next time, or they can pay a \$2 deposit which is refundable on return of the piece.
